School of the Environment: Collaborative Specialization in Environmental Studies (CSES)

Below you will find the requirements for students completing the Master of Global Affairs program who are completing a Collaborative Specialization in Environmental Studies. Although this document will provide you with guidance for completing the specialization, note that the <u>School of Graduate Studies</u> <u>Calendar</u> is the authoritative source for all degree requirements.

Master of Global Affairs (MGA)

MGA students complete a total of 8.5 FCEs. Students enrolled in the Collaborative Specialization in Environmental Studies must have at least 30% of their coursework (2.5 FCEs) count towards the CSES and complete the following collaborative specialization requirements:

- ENV 1001H: Environmental Decision Making (0.5 FCE)
- One elective (0.5 FCE) from the <u>CSES course list.</u>
- GLA1007H (0.5 FCE) which satisfies the CSES internship requirement provided there is an environment related component. A letter confirming the completion of the internship must be submitted to the School of the Environment prior to convocation.
- One of GLA2095H or GLA2888H (0.5 FCE) which satisfies the CSES research paper requirement provided there is an environment related component. A copy of the final research paper must be submitted to the School of the Environment prior to convocation.
- GLA2000Y (1.0 FCE), which counts towards the CSES requirements.
