School of the Environment: Collaborative Specialization in Environmental Studies (CSES)

Below you will find the requirements for students in the MSc Sustainability Management program who are completing a Collaborative Specialization in Environmental Studies. Although this document will provide you with guidance for completing the specialization, note that the [School of Graduate Studies Calendar](#) is the authoritative source for all degree requirements.

Master of Science in Sustainability Management (MScSM)

MScSM students complete a total of 8.0 FCEs. Students enrolled in the Collaborative Specialization in Environmental Studies must have at least 30% of their coursework (2.5 FCEs) count towards the CSES and complete the following collaborative specialization requirements:

- ENV 1001H: *Environmental Decision Making* (0.5 FCE)
- One elective (0.5 FCE) from the [CSES course list](#).
- SSM1110H: Sustainability Management Internship (0.5 FCE) satisfies the CSES internship requirement. *A letter confirming the completion of the internship must be submitted to the School of the Environment prior to convocation.*
- SSM1100Y/SSM1101Y: Research Paper (I or II) (1.0 FCE) satisfies the CSES research paper requirement. *A copy of the final research paper must be submitted to the School of the Environment prior to convocation.*
